This should bring you to the end of the square.

To Finish

One round of Double Crochet (UK) was worked around the edge in Citron

One round of Treble Crochet (UK) was worked into the Double Crochet

One round of Double Crochet (UK) worked into the Treble Crochet

Finally work the border of your choice into the final round of Double Crochet. I used a shell pattern worked in Gold working 8 Treble Crochet (UK) into the the middle stitch of 7. I will try to do a picture tutorial of this at some point.
